EXPERIENCE

Shepparton Heritage Centre Museum:
Take a step back in time and immerse yourself in history as you stand inside Shepparton's oldest surviving building.

Australian Botanic Gardens:
Explore and enjoy the beauty of the evolving gardens, take in the views of the lookout from Honeysuckle Rise, relax at the picnic tables, and walk or bike around the numerous trails.

Riverlinks:

Bangerang Cultural Centre:
Here you will see a unique collection of indigenous art and artefacts explaining the wide and rich culture of the local people.

Shepparton War Memorial and Cenotaph:
This memorial commemorates the residents of Shepparton who served in World War I and II.

MOVE:

The Museum of Vehicle Evolution displays motor cars, trucks, buses and more. Be sure to walk through the Kenworth Dealer Pavilion, immerse yourself in the Furphy Museum, and take a step through time with the extraordinary Loel Thomson Costume Collection.

Telstra Tower :

Shepparton Art Museum (SAM):

Experience, support, understand and connect with local Aboriginal culture through this Community Art Centre & Gallery.

Moooving Art:
A herd of over 90 ever-changing, colourful fibreglass cows scattered throughout parks, gardens, public spaces and businesses across Shepparton & Goulburn Valley, each one individual and distinctive in their persona. How many can you find?

Aboriginal Street Art:
The Aboriginal Street Art Project celebrates and recognises the local Aboriginal history. There are 5 spectacular murals to see for yourself.

Street Art and Murals:
The art scene is alive and well in Shepparton, you will find an abundance of murals and street art throughout.

Mouse Hunt:
Located at an ever-growing number of Shepparton businesses are tiny little mice created by a local artist.

Test out your skills on this impressive 18 hole course set across 5 acres of gardens. After a round pop next door to the Chocolate Apple Factory for a well earned treat!


Aquamoves:
